Configuring data collection intervals

When you register SQL Server instances, you can configure your data collection intervals. These settings are located on the first tab of the wizard that allows you to add SQL Server instances, for more information go to Adding SQL Server instances.

The data collection settings that you can specify are the following:

- Collection Interval how often SQL Enterprise Job Manager collects information for your instance, specified in minutes or days.
- Keep data for how often data is groomed from the monitored SQL Instance, specified in days.
