

# Port requirements

To ensure the SQL Compliance Manager Agent and Collection Server can successfully audit instances in your environment, open the following ports. For more information, see [Supported installation scenarios](#).

Environment Type	Port Requirements
Typical	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Port 5201 on the Collection Server computer</li><li>• Port 5200 on each computer hosting an audited SQL Server instance</li></ul>
Clustered	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Port 5201 on the Collection Server computer</li><li>• Port 5200 on each cluster node hosting a virtual SQL Server you want to audit</li></ul>
Non-trusted	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Port 5201 on the Collection Server computer</li><li>• Port 5200 on each computer hosting an audited SQL Server instance in a non-trusted domain or workgroup</li></ul>
