Auto-refresh settings

By default, IDERA SQL Inventory Manager performs an auto refresh process every five minutes (300 seconds). You can edit this setting following these steps.

- Go to <InstallDir>\Inventory Manager\WebApplication\idera-main\conf\web.properties
- In the web.properties files add the following property: AutoRefreshInterval=<time>

Where *<time>* is the time interval in seconds you want to specify for auto refresh. You can define this value from 60 seconds (1minute) to 600 seconds (10 minutes).

▲ Take into account the following considerations:

- In order for the changes to take effect, you need to restart the Inventory Manager Web service after setting the Autorefresh configurations value.
- If you introduce a value that is outside the limits or in a different format, it will take 60 seconds for values under the lower limit, 600 seconds for values over the higher limit, and 300 seconds for values in the wrong format.
- Adjusting the auto-refresh interval may impact performance
