

## Policy Wizard - Name the policy

The **Summary** tab allows you to include a name and description for the policy. Check **Enable Policy** to activate this policy.

SQL Defrag Manager uses the **Caution** and **Critical** fragmentation level options to perform automated responses as defined in the **Response** tab.

You are required to enter a unique name for each policy.

Both the name and description appear in the status messages for your policies. Using a meaningful name and description allows you to easily identify problems when they occur. For example, consider specifying a description that help you later choose the correct backup to restore during a disaster recovery situation.
