## **Configure cluster settings**

If you have a clustered environment, SQL Diagnostic Manager can trigger an alert whenever a cluster is running on a non-preferred node. The preferred cluster node is the "active" node in a cluster. By default, the preferred cluster node is the first node added when deploying SQL Diagnostic Manager in your clustered environment.

## **Access the Cluster Settings tab**

You can access the Cluster Settings tab of the Monitor SQL Server Properties window by right-clicking the appropriate monitored SQL Server instance, and then selecting **Properties**. Click **Cluster Settings** when SQL Diagnostic Manager displays the Monitored SQL Server Properties window.
