## **Managing alerts**

SQL Enterprise Job Manager displays alerts that warn you about the status of your instances and jobs/tasks. These alerts depend on alert rules that you can configure and customize according to your needs in the **Alerts Rules** tab.

SQL Enterprise Job Manager has three default alert rules:

- SQL Server instance connection failures
- SQL Server Agent not running
- Job Failures

On the **Alerts Rules** tab, you can change the settings of these alert rules, you can create your own new alert rules, enable/disable, or subscribe /unsubscribe to alert rules. The following sections explain in detail how to perform these actions.



Read-only users cannot create/edit or remove alert rules in the **Alert Rules** tab but they can view alert rules properties and subscribe /unsubscribe to individual or to all critical alert rules.
