<b>Bold</b>	Window items
<i>Italics</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Book and CD titles</li><li>• Variable names</li><li>• New terms</li></ul>
Fixed Font	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• File and directory names</li><li>• Commands and code examples</li><li>• Text typed by you</li></ul>
Straight brackets, as in [value]	Optional command parameters
Curly braces, as in {value}	Required command parameters
Logical OR, as in value 1   value 2	Exclusively command parameters where only one of the options can be specified
