

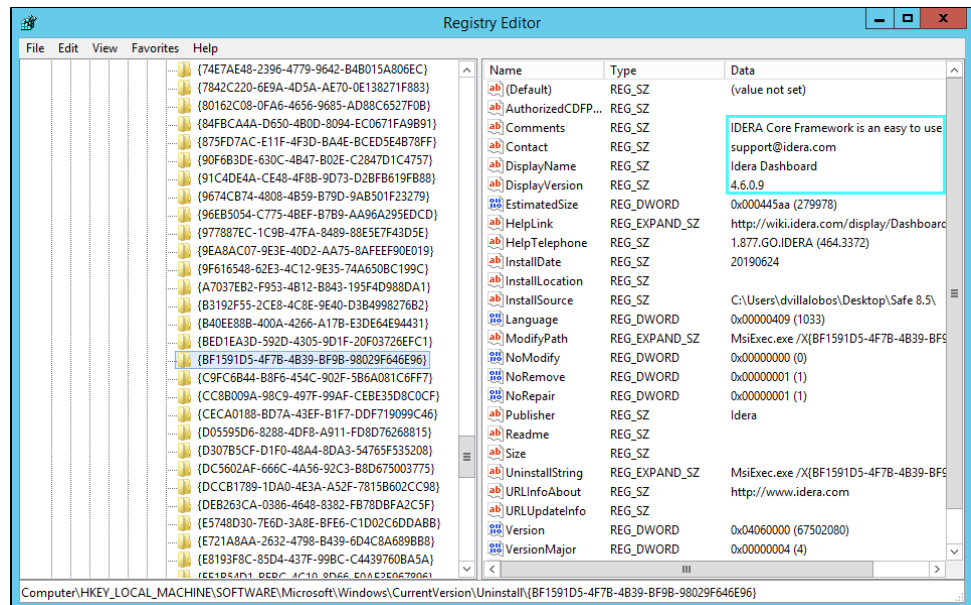
Uninstalling the IDERA Dashboard



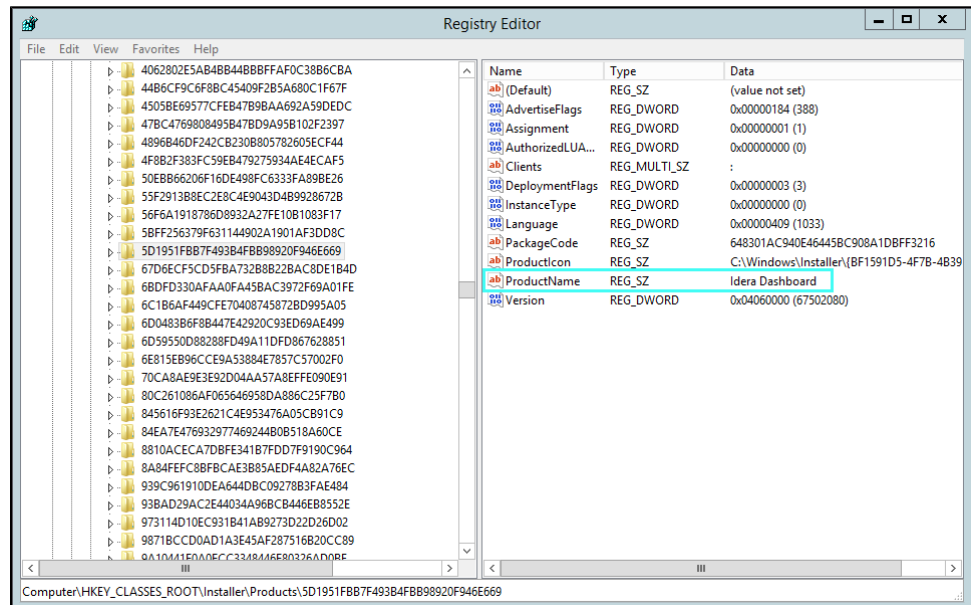
At the end of the process, you need to reboot the server.

The uninstallation process requires a list of steps to delete all services:

1. Back up the Windows Registry as a safety measure.
2. Stop the **Idera Dashboard Core Service** and the **Idera Dashboard Web Application Service** at the Services window.
3. Open the Command Prompt and execute:
 - a. `sc delete IderaDashboardCoreService`
 - b. `sc delete IderaDashboardWebAppService`
4. Open the Registry Editor and delete the following registry keys:
 - a. Delete CWF from: `KEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\Idera`
 - b. Locate and Delete the IDERA Dashboard GUID from: `HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\Microsoft\Windows\CurrentVersion\Uninstall`



- c. Locate and Delete the Dashboard GUID from: `KEY_CLASSES_ROOT\Installer\Products`



5. Reboot the server.
6. Delete the entire Dashboard folder from: `C:\Program Files\Idera`
7. Run the Command Prompt as Administrator and execute: `msiexec /i "C:\Program Files\Idera\SQLdm x64 Installation Kit\64\IderaDashboard.msi" /L*v %USERPROFILE%\Desktop\DashboardInstall.txt`
