

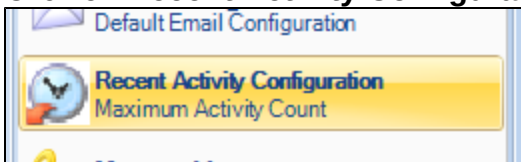
Recent activity configuration

By default, SQL Defrag Manager only displays the last 1000 actions on the Recent Activity pane. Starting with version 3.5 users can change this value in the SQL Defrag Manager Console or through the command line.

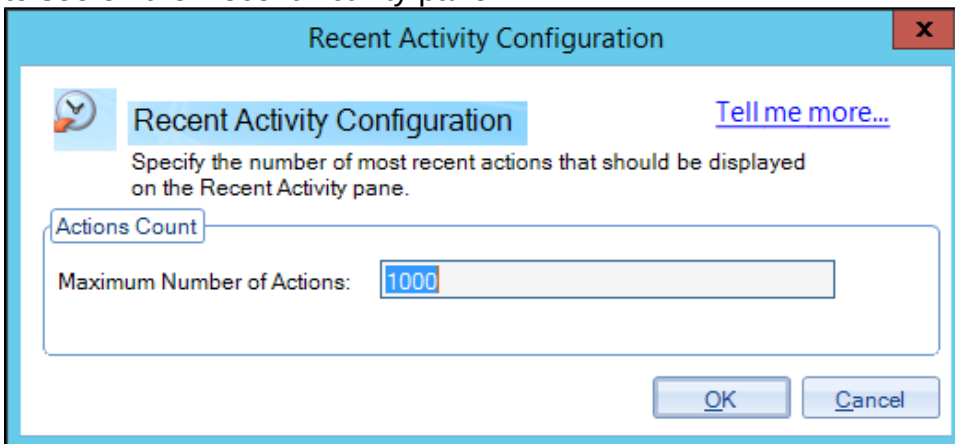
Changing the value on the SQL Defrag Manager Console

To access the **Recent Activity Configuration** dialog follow these steps:

1. Click on the SQL Defrag Manager icon to open the **Command Menu**.

2. Click on **Recent Activity Configuration**.



3. On the **Recent Activity Configuration** dialog set the number of recent actions you want to see on the Recent Activity pane.



Changing the value on the Command line

Open the command line and use the following command.

```
sqldefragc.exe -set -maxIndexes <value>
```

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
