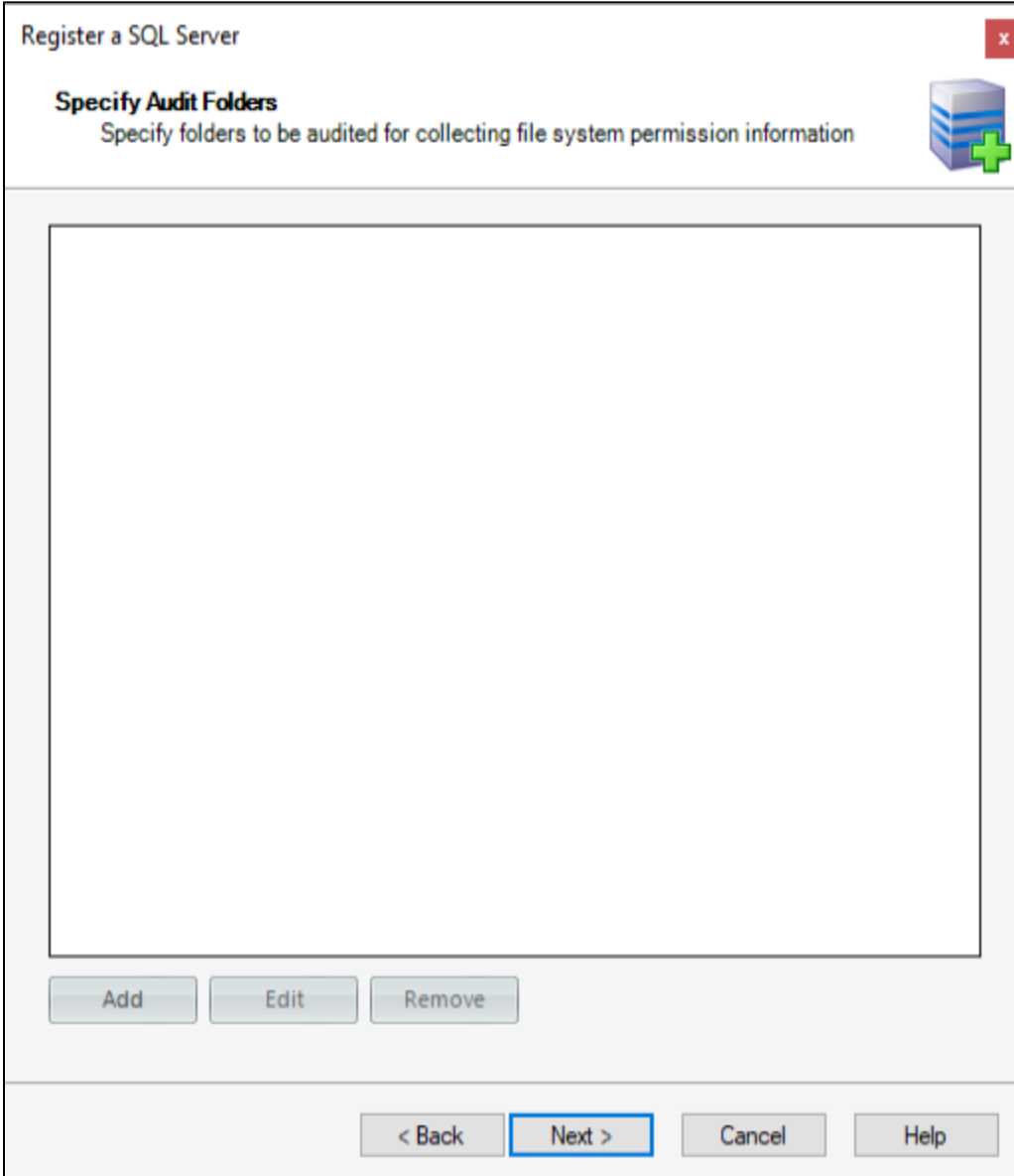


Define folders for file system permissions checks

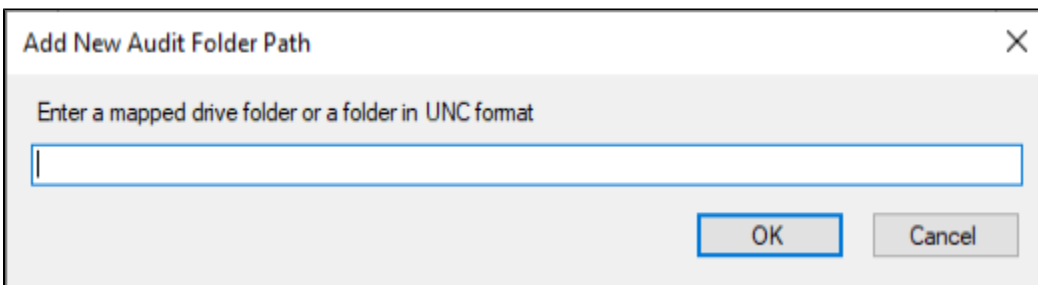
In the **Specify Audit Folders** section, you can select which folders will be audited for collecting file system permission information.

 Amazon RDS accounts do not have this option available.
