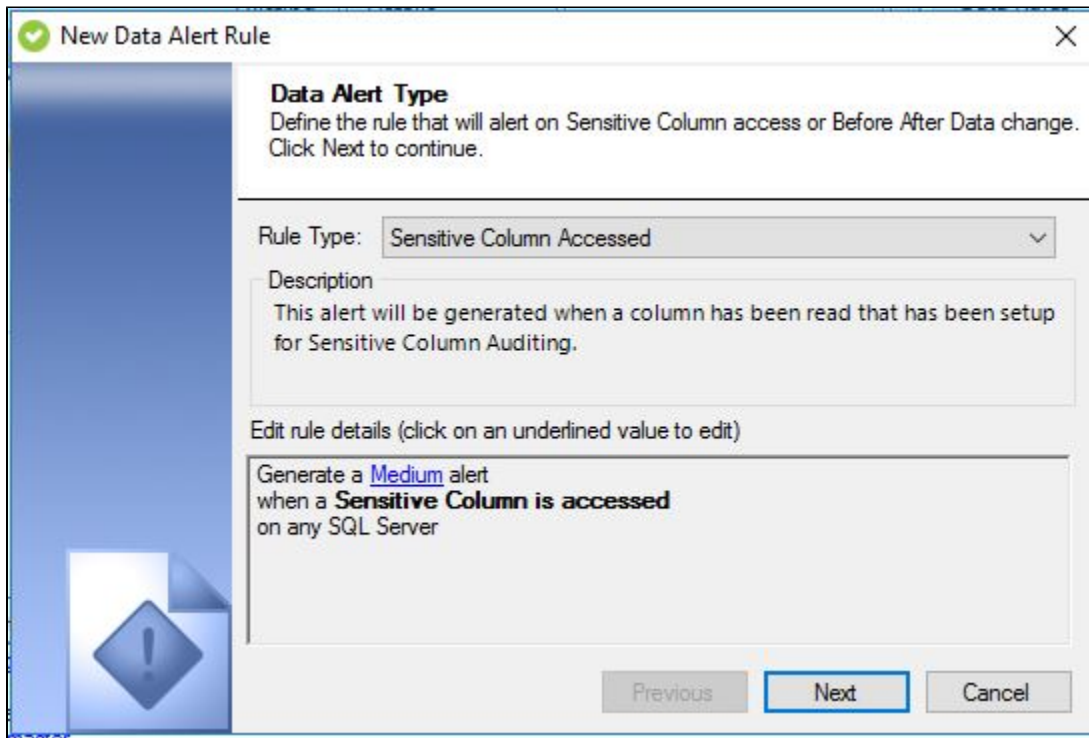


New Data Alert Rule wizard - Data Alert Type tab
