## Available upgrade paths

Each component can be installed separately on different computers, the type of upgrade you will need to perform will depend on your environment.

The following table describes the conditions under which you would follow a typical or staged upgrade path:

| Backup Agents from different SQL Safe Backup versions.  | Sta<br>ged                              | An environment that manages Backup Agents from different SQL Safe Backup versions requires a staged upgrade in order to maintain a connection with all Backup Agents while each component is upgraded. |
| Change control policies that require multi-phased upgrades.   | Sta<br>ged                              | An environment with stringent change control policies requires a multi-phased upgrade in order to test each updated component thoroughly before moving on to the next step.                            |
