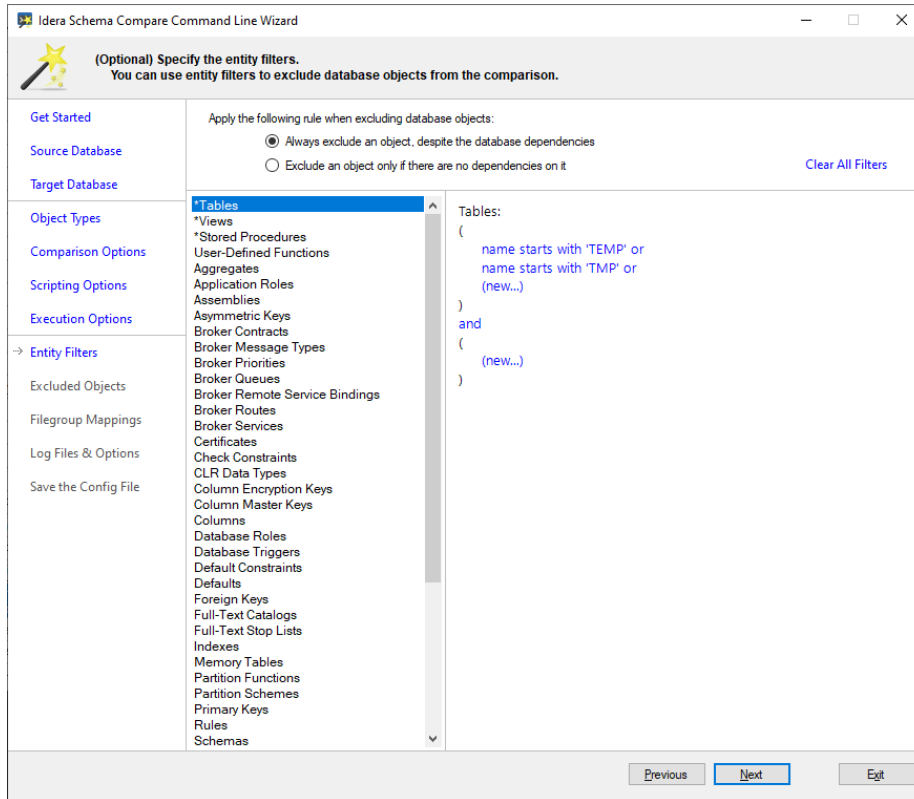


SQL Schema Compare Command Line Excluding Objects Using Entity Filters
