The Disk Space History report provides the history of activity for a specific disk. To access this report, click **Reports** in the Navigation pane, then select **Resources > Disk Space History** in the Analyze menu.

When to run this report

You can run the Disk Space History report to locate a new database by analyzing available disk space and level of activity.

How SQL Diagnostic Manager calculates metric values on this report

Most values on the Disk Space History report correlate with the related SQL Server metric. However, some metric values represent averages over time. Likewise, a few metric values are based on performance algorithms that use multiple statistics to calculate a more accurate metric.
