Navigate the SQLDM Web Console

The SQLDM Web Console is a development that allows users to get an overview of the status of small and large SQL Diagnostic Manager deployments, which you can use on your computer or mobile device. Besides, SQLDM Web Console allows you to perform some other actions such as personalizing the interface and finding SQL Diagnostic Documentation support with the following options:


My Profile
