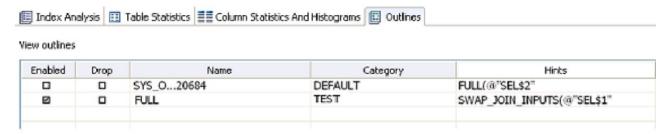
## **Using the Outlines tab (Oracle)**

The Outlines tab provides detailed information about outlines created by the query during the statement execution process on the Overview tab.

It provides information including the SQL statement name, whether the outline is enabled, and the Name, Category, and Hints associated with the outline. Additionally, the Drop parameter specifies whether it is dropped at execution time.



In order to view outlines, the session needs to have USE\_STORED\_OUTLINES=true set prior to execution. Outlines in tuning are created for the DEFAULT category, by default. Use the following commands to enable outlines with the default settings:

alter system set USE\_STORED\_OUTLINES=true; alter system set USE\_STORED\_OUTLINES='DEFAULT'; alter session set USE\_STORED\_OUTLINES=true;

Additionally, in order for a session to <code>USE\_STORED\_OUTLINES</code>, the user requires the create any outline role. Use the following command to set up the proper permissions:

grant create any outline to [user];
