

# Subscribing to Alerts

IDERA SQL Inventory Manager can send email notifications for warning or critical conditions from your environment, in order to receive these notifications you have to subscribe to alerts.

To subscribe, go to the **Administration** tab, and in the **Alert Emails** section, click **Subscribe to alerts**.
