

SQL Data Compare Excluding Database Objects

You can exclude specific tables or views from data compare by listing them under the xml element `<TablePairs>` or `<ViewPairs>`.

Rules for excluding database objects are as follows:

- The attribute Action of `<Pair>` element should be set to Exclude
- The left and right object must be both specified for each excluded pair

The following xml fragment excludes the tables `dbo.Employees` and `dbo.Customers` from the comparison:

<TablePairs>
  <Pair Action="Exclude">
    <LeftObject Name="dbo.Employees"></LeftObject>
    <RightObject Name="dbo.Employees"></RightObject>
  </Pair>
  <Pair Action="Exclude">
    <LeftObject Name="dbo.Customers"></LeftObject>
    <RightObject Name="dbo.Customers"></RightObject>
  </Pair>
</TablePairs>
```
