Ø	Apply regulation guidelines to the audited databases on your registered SQL Server instances.
Ø	Track the collected SQL Server events over time and fine tune your audit settings as needed.
Ø	Configure Event Alerts to notify you when suspicious events occur in your environment.
Ø	Configure Status Alerts to notify you when SQL Compliance Manager experiences an issue.
