

# Managing alerts

SQL Enterprise Job Manager displays alerts that warn you about the status of your instances, jobs, and tasks. These alerts depend on the alert rules that you configure and customize according to your needs in the **Alerts Rules** tab.

SQL Enterprise Job Manager has three default alert rules:

- SQL Server Instance Connection Failures
- SQL Server Agent Not Running
- Job Failures

On the **Alerts Rules** tab, you can change the settings of these alert rules. For example, you can [create your own new alert rules](#), [perform actions](#) such as enable/disable, or [subscribe/unsubscribe](#) to alert rules. The following sections explain in detail how to perform these actions.



Read-only users cannot create/edit or remove alert rules in the **Alert Rules** tab, but they can view alert rules properties and subscribe/unsubscribe to the individual or to all critical alert rules.
