

Managing instances in the IDERA Dashboard

The IDERA Dashboard tracks SQL Server instances, discovered and managed by different IDERA products. The Instances widget of the Administration view, allows users to view and manage registered instances.

To view coverage or remove registered instances that no longer exist in your SQL Server environment, select **Manage Instances** in the Administration view, and the Managed Instances window displays. The View filter allows you to select from:

- **All** - Lists all instances discovered in your SQL Server environment and network.
- **Managed** - Lists only those managed instances in various IDERA products.
- **Unmanaged** - Lists instances discovered on the network but not registered.

Instances

The Idera Dashboard tracks SQL Server instances discovered and managed by Idera products. Use Manage Instances to view and manage the list.

Products

The Idera Dashboard hosts products that register with the dashboard. Typically this is the Products option lets you view and manage the list of registered products.

Manage Products

Tips

The Idera Dashboard stores a list of all the SQL Server instances known by Idera products. This includes instances managed by the products as well as those discovered on the network. This lets you review your entire SQL Server environment and its coverage in areas such as backup, security and performance.

Instances are registered from the individual products. With this view you can review the coverage or delete instances that no longer exist in your environment.
