

Object Level Recovery operations

The Object Level Recovery (OLR) option allows you to restore one or more individual objects from a SQL Safe format backup set instead of having to restore the whole database.

How do you access the Object Level Recovery Wizard?

You can access the Object Level Recovery Wizard from any of the following paths:

- On the **Servers** tab, go to the **All Databases** view, right-click the instance or database from where you want to recover objects, and select **Object Level Recovery**.
- From any tab, go to the **File** menu, and select **Object Level Recovery**.
- You can also find this option on the **SQL Safe Today** view, by going to the **Common tasks** and then selecting **Object Level Recovery**.
