

# Edit Policies CLI Commands

SQL Safe provides you with CLI commands to help you manually edit your policies.

To edit policies use the following commands:

- SQLsafeCmd Edit-Policy <policy\_name> [options]
- SQLsafeCmd Edit-Policy <policy\_GUID> [options]

Where:

Action	Description
<policy_name>	Name of the policy.
<policy_GUID>	GUID of the policy.

## Advanced Options

The following advanced options help you edit policies:

Options	Description
-ArgsFile <filename>	The path to a file containing command-line arguments.  <filename> - specifies the file that contains the command line arguments.
