

## Browse archives on the TSM Server

The available backup archives can be viewed (browsed) by right-clicking the target SQL Server instance in the **Servers** navigation pane and selecting **Browse TSM Archives**. You can also view this information through the SQL Safe Restore wizard, CLI, or XSP. You can view a list of all available files including those flagged as inactive.

To browse the TSM Server through the Restore wizard, select **Tivoli Storage Manager** on the Source tab, and then click **Browse**.

To use the XSP browse command, see the sample XSP scripts available from the Programs menu.

Example CLI code snippets that use the browse command

**To browse all active files:**

```
SQLsafeCmd Browse TSM
```

**To browse all active and inactive files:**

```
SQLsafeCmd Browse TSM -TSMIncludeInactive
```

**To browse all active and inactive files in a Highlevel called BACKUP:**

```
SQLsafeCmd Browse TSM -TSMIncludeInactive -TSMHighLevel BACKUP
```



TSM is case sensitive. Be careful when specifying the High Level and Low Level file set.
